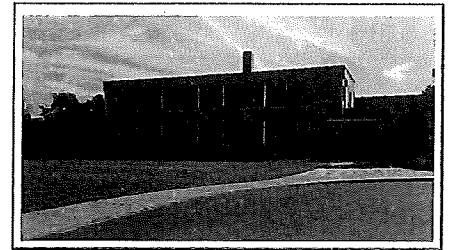

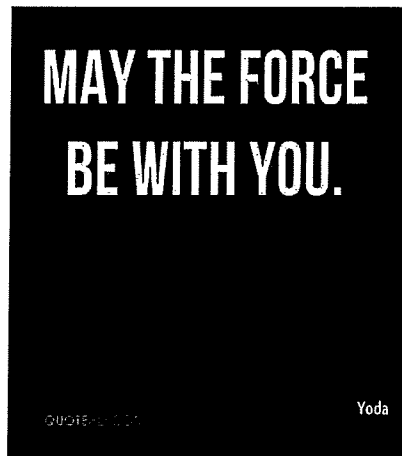
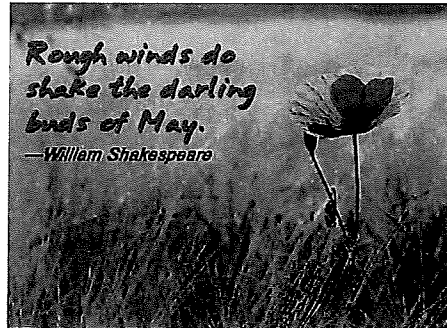

Important reminders for students and families:
