# **Enrollment**

CCHS begins "formal" enrollment starting on July 1st. However, we are ready to issue re-enrollment packets to all students returning to CCHS in the fall as well as new enrollment packets for students interested in enrolling at CCHS for 2020-2021. Returning students should expect re-enrollment paperwork in June with their final report cards. You can also expect a phone call within the next few weeks asking if your student is returning.

- Graduating Seniors: We can only issue one diploma. Take good care of it. We do not keep a backup diploma. For employers, colleges, and the military, they require a transcript, not a diploma.
- Graduating Seniors, please let us know if you ever need a transcript. Official transcripts with our raised seal in a sealed envelope cost \$5.00 each. Unofficial transcripts are free.
- If you have moved or changed your phone number, please update the school with the correct information.

### SCHOOL DAY

The school day will consist of four class blocks of approximately 85 minutes, five days per week.

The school campus will be closed once school has begun. Students who leave the building will not be re-admitted unless they have been at an excused doctor's visit or other scheduled appointment with verification from the parent or have obtained staff permission before leaving the building. They must come to the school office to be readmitted to the building. If a student's first arrival to school is after lunch (34 block) then the 40 minute tardy policy applies.

#### COVID 19 Schedule for 2020-2021

The daily schedule for 2020-2021 is designed to help us apply social distancing requirements and be better prepared should we find ourselves in another *STAY HOME STAY SAFE* executive order. Students will either be an A.M. Seat Time student with required home online learning for the afternoon or they will be required to be a P.M. Seat Time student while doing online learning at home in the morning. Students who require face-to-face support for online learning will be required to schedule time with one of our tutors in advance. Seat space for online support will be limited to maintain social distancing requirements. We will offer two lunch periods; one for the A.M. seat time students followed by a half hour departure/sanitizing timeframe. The second lunch period for P.M. seat time students will be the first part of their day before going to class.
